Privacy notice

Who we are

When we say 'we', we mean the Engineering Integrity Society, which is a charity and company limited by guarantee, and any individual who is sub-contracted by us to deliver our services.

The information that we collect

We collect information about you

- when you join as a personal member or part of a corporate member,
- when you make an enquiry about our courses, workshops, seminars, conferences, journal, newsletters or other services,
- when you, or your employer, or its agents book you onto one of our courses, workshops, seminars, conferences or other services,
- when you submit information for our journal or newsletters,
- from publicly available sources.

We will only collect information in line with relevant regulations and law.

In return, we ask you to make sure that you give us accurate and up to date information. If you provide information for another person, for example if you book them onto a seminar, you will need to tell them how to find the Privacy Notice and make sure they agree to us using their information for the purposes set out in it.

What we do with your information

- We will use your information to provide any services that you have requested and also to inform you about our services, unless you ask us not to.
- We do not process your personal information, undertake analysis of it, pass it to third parties or monitor traffic to our website.
- We will only use your information where we are allowed to by law, because we have a legitimate business interest or where you agree to it.
